## **FALL 2015 NOTES POOL**

The Virginia Journal of Criminal Law will be accepting submissions for its Fall notes pool (note to be published in the Summer 2016 issue). Submissions will be accepted ending at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2015.

If you are interested in submitting a note:

- 1) The typical length of a note is somewhere between 8,500 – 15,000 words, including footnotes. Successful notes have a clear criminal law connection, are well-written, and offer a unique perspective on an issue. If you do not have an original note already, you might consider adapting your writing requirement paper, a seminar paper, or brief. - 2) Email your note to [vjcl.uva@gmail.com](mailto:vjcl.uva@gmail.com). Include “VJCL Notes Pool” in the subject line.
- 3) Do not include identifying information in the note or file name.
- 4) Include a second document in your submission email, containing your: 1) Name; 2) Title of the Note; 3) Email; 4) Phone number. If you are a VJCL Member, please note this.
- 5) Your note should be your own work. Please indicate any students, professors, attorneys, etc. you collaborated with in the document.
